### Discontinuing Hoopla & Kanopy

These services ended on 6/30/2025





At the Portage Lake District Library, we are always looking for ways to enhance the value and experience of our resources. After careful review, we have made the decision to transition away from our Hoopla and Kanopy subscriptions due to rising costs associated with the pay-per-checkout lending model. While we know this may be disappointing for some of our patrons, we remain optimistic about providing new opportunities ahead for our digital offerings.

This change reflects a broader trend where libraries across the country are re-evaluating their pay-per-checkout lending model subscriptions due to similar challenges. The library is dedicated to providing our community with a wide range of quality digital content, and we're thrilled to continue doing so through platforms like Libby and Michigan eLibrary (MeL).

It's important to remember that the library service model has always been one of collective sharing and taking turns borrowing. This sometimes means longer wait periods for very popular titles. Our knowledgeable staff members are available to help you navigate our existing resources and find the titles you are looking for.

We remain hopeful for the future and will monitor any potential pricing changes with Hoopla and Kanopy. Should Hoopla adjust its lending model to better align with library budgets, we'll be happy to reconsider offering their services again in the future. #### Expect adjusted wait times for Inter-Library Loans

Inter-library loans are one of PLDL's more popular features, and that service will fully continue with one change.

Beginning July 1, you may notice a slight delay in receiving your interlibrary loan materials because PLDL will be going from a five- to three-day delivery schedule as a cost-saving measure. It is currently expected for items to take several weeks to arrive, depending on the lending-library location and wait lists. Choosing a specific library (for example one that is closer physically to us) is no guarantee the item will arrive any faster as each library has its own schedule and sorting system. There is no action the library can take to rush a hold unless the item has been in transit for more than three weeks. Please be patient with us.

When participating in the ILL system, please leave all labels, book bands, and paperwork that arrived with your inter-library loan material with the item. These are used to identify books and are a requirement of the cooperative system. Failure to do so may result in a temporary ban of using the inter-library loan program. In addition, please make sure you check the local catalog (Resource Sharing Libraries) before attempting to use the MeLCat system. MeLCat items that could have been ordered through the local system are unlikely to be filled.

Following those protocols will ensure that your inter-library loans continue to go smoothly.

#### Library app makes life easy

The easiest digital access patrons have to all of your library services is through the Superiorland Library Co-op. Simply download the app through the app store on your smartphone and log in with your library card number and PIN – the image above is the same one that appears on the app.

Once in, you'll be able to manage your library accounts, search for Inter-Library Loans, and access LIBBY, which gives you access to a large selection of ebooks and audiobooks.

#### Get out your library cards!

PLDL is tightening up our checkout procedure by requiring a library card to scan from each patron.

This is our way of making sure that all materials are checked out to the right accounts and generally strengthening our security practices.

Even if we've known you forever, we'll scan your card at check-out. For anyone who has lost their card, we can easily issue a new one.

There may be a small fee to replace lost cards – talk to circulation staff for details.






